ARE YOU A CURIOUS PILOT?

Do you ask questions (to yourself or others) as to why we do what we do as a pilot? We should question everything we do in an aircraft. What if your instructor is wrong? (instructors can be, and are, wrong at times) Besides, that answer provides no display, or depth, of knowledge.

The idea is to be more knoweldgeable, which, when applied with critical thinking, leads to better decision making, and hopefully better action. It can also lead to more confidence as a pilot. We all need to continuously work on better decision making. This is especially important when emergencies occur.
